The Kansas Range Youth Camp is designed to give the students a basic understanding of the principles of rangeland ecology, including plant physiology, plant identification, range sites, range condition, and trend. Students selected to participate should have a serious interest in rangeland management, rangeland ecology, or grazing animals. Registration is limited to students who will begin their sophomore, junior or senior year of high school in the fall of 2012.

Each camper will receive a camp information packet via mail by early June. This packet will include location maps, agenda, and list of participants. During camp each participant will receive a range youth camp t-shirt and notebook filled with presentations and handouts. After camp a CD-ROM of pictures highlighting activities at the camp will be mailed to each participant. Copies can also be made for sponsors for presentation purposes upon request.
